## Grading:

You have up to the next unit test to reassess. Since I allow for re-takes on the test no extra credit will be offered in this course.

## Homework Policy:

Late work will be accepted for full credit up to the unit test. After the unit test is completed, late work will no longer be accepted for that unit. Homework will be discussed in class and for you to get the most out of the discussion I would suggest doing the homework on time. .

## Make up or Absent work:
